Immunization Requirements for International Students
2016/17 School Year

The State of Ohio law (ORC 3313.67 and 3313.671) requires the following immunizations for school attendance for High School students. All immunizations must be received prior to the first day of class. Written proof from a health care provider is needed to verify that immunizations are complete.

DTaP/DT, Tdap/Td (Diphtheria, Tetanus and Pertussis):

Four (4) or more DTaP or DT, or any combination.

OR

Three (3) doses of Td or a combination of Td and Tdap is the minimum acceptable.

Tdap: One (1) dose required prior to school entry for grades 7-12.

Polio: Three (3) or more doses of IPV or OPV. If the third dose of either series was received prior to the fourth birthday, a fourth (4) dose is required.

OR

If a combination of OPV and IPV was received, four (4) doses of either vaccine are required.

MMR (Measles, Mumps and Rubella): Two (2) doses are required.

HEP B (Hepatitis B): Three (3) doses of hepatitis B are required.

Varicella (Chicken pox): One (1) dose of varicella vaccine must be administered on or after the first birthday for Freshmen (grade 9) and Sophomores (grade 10).

Meningococcal (MCV4): Two (2) doses of meningococcal (serogroup A, C, W and Y) vaccine must be administered for Senior (grade 12) students. If the first (1st) dose was administered on or after the 16th birthday, a second (2nd) dose is not required.
